### **Scams and Preventions**



#### **Phone Scams**

Common scam offers include free product trials, cash prizes, cheap travel packages, medical devices, preapproved loans, debt reduction, and low-risk, high-return investments.

Prevention: Verify the number calling you or hang up!



### **Internet Scams**

Fraudulent websites designed to look like official government or shopping websites.

**Prevention:** Double check the URL name you are on for misspellings or site seal of authenticity.



### **Email Scams**

Phishing emails are fake or spoof emails pretending to be from your bank or organization. The email will ask you to visit the link and enter your account details.

**Prevention:** Verify the email sender name.
